

Emergency Notification and Information

If you need to report an injury, accident, or emergency situation on campus, dial 911 then contact a Campus Security Authority (CSA). See below for a list of campus CSA's.

Emergency Information: IN THE CASE OF AN EMERGENCY, LAGUNA COLLEGE OR ART AND DESIGN WILL COMMUNICATE TO OUR STUDENTS, FACULTY, AND STAFF VIA E-MAIL, TELEPHONE, AND TEXT MESSAGING (OMNILERT)

During an emergency, campus officials will work as quickly as possible to provide accurate information. Authorized campus security personnel will test the College's emergency notification system and conduct evacuation procedures annually.

Additional Alert Resources: AlertOC is Orange County's Emergency Notification System. You can register with AlertOC, to receive time-sensitive messages when a public safety issue affects your residence or business. The messages can be delivered via phone, text message, email, and TTY/TDD receiving devices for the hearing impaired. All contact information is confidential and will only be used for AlertOC emergency notifications.

Crisis: If you are a student in crisis and need assistance, consider campus counseling- Even after the immediate crisis has passed, counseling and medical assistance referral may be sought from the Student Services Office, with the knowledge that the information received will remain confidential. LCAD's campus counselor provides mental health counseling and is available to students on a weekly basis. Contact the Student Services Office to arrange an appointment.
