Important Note: The instructions below apply to the student and spouse, if the student is married. Notify the financial aid office if the student or spouse filed separate IRS income tax returns for 2021 or had a change in marital status after the end of the 2021 tax year on December 31, 2021.

Instructions: Complete this section if the student and spouse filed or will file a 2021 IRS income tax return(s). The best way to verify income is by using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool (IRS DRT) that is part of FAFSA on the Web at FAFSA.gov. In most cases, for electronic filers, a 2021 IRS Tax Return Transcript may be requested from the IRS within 2–3 weeks after the 2021 IRS income tax return has been accepted by the IRS. Generally, for filers of 2021 paper IRS income tax returns, the 2021 IRS Tax Return Transcript may be requested within 8–11 weeks after the 2021 paper IRS income tax return has been received by the IRS.

If the student and spouse filed separate 2021 IRS income tax returns, 2021 IRS Tax Return Transcripts must be provided for both.

Your financial aid administrator will need to validate the statement below at the time of submission by maintaining a copy of your photo ID and by providing a signature and date. *If you cannot appear in person to submit this worksheet, you will need to provide a copy of your government issued ID and this worksheet notarized by a public notary*.
